Policy & General Purposes Committee <u>Constitution & Terms of Reference</u>

Membership

All Parish Councillors and five co-opted members, appointed annually by the Parish Council at its Annual Meeting.

The Quorum shall consist of THREE Councillor members of the Committee.

The Parish Council may approve the co-option of additional named persons who are not Councillors to serve on the Committee on a short-term basis. They will not have voting rights.

The Committee recognises the need to co-opt specialist / professional person(s) to advise and support the Committee and that such people should be approached when necessary.

Terms of Reference

The Committee is responsible for

• the review and development of Council policies relating to all aspects of the Council's activities and recommending

a) changes to existing Policies to the Council for approval and

b) new policies to the Council for adoption.

- the development of the Council's projects.
- carrying out the Annual Inspection of Property and preparing and Action Plan.

Delegated Powers

The Committee considers matters in detail and has delegated authority to:

- make decisions with regard to any function relating to Council policies;
- respond to consultations;
- make decisions relating to the non-strategic management of land owned or occupied by the Council;
- make decisions with regard to any function under s.144 of LGA 1972 relating to the promotion of tourism;
- make decisions with regard to any function under s.145 of LGA 1972 relating to the management of a festival;
- comment on planning applications and development plans affecting Shevington Parish and adjacent areas;
- instruct the Proper Officer to act.

In all other matters it has powers of recommendation only. Decisions of a financial nature must referred either to the Finance Committee or to the Full Council.

Voting Rights

All Councillor members have full voting rights.

Co-opted committee members only have voting rights in respect of:

- the non-strategic management of land owned or occupied by the Council;
- any function under s.144 of LGA 1972 relating to the promotion of tourism;
- any function under s.145 of LGA 1972 relating to the management of a festival.

Meetings

The Committee meets on the first Thursday of every month, except January and July, when there is no meeting.
