2018 Budget & Precept

We have set a precept this year of £69,449. This is £449 more than last year and will enable us to fulfill all of our existing maintenance commitments and to continue to support the 'in Bloom' groups in their work and their bids for awards in the 2018 North West in Bloom competition. Because of the increased number of properties in the Parish, when you get your bill you will find that your parish council tax will not have increased since

Five years ago we secured a loan to purchase land in the Vicarage Lane area for use by the community. Last year saw work commencing on the land to convert it into playing fields and this year the work on the allotments site should begin. We are continuing to try to find ways of improving the drainage in Shevington Memorial Park. In 2018 we will again receive a grant from Wigan Council. The annual repayment of the loan for the land purchase would have resulted in the precept having to be increased by £8,000, but we have used the grant and our reserves

to keep the precept at a level at which it will have no impact on your household finances. We estimate that on 1 April 2018 our reserves will stand at approximately £61,800.

Some of Shevington's car parks will be closed from Friday, 29 June late evening to facilitate


the Fete. Free car parking will be provided at Shevington High School with a free shuttle taxi service to and from the centre of Shevington.
